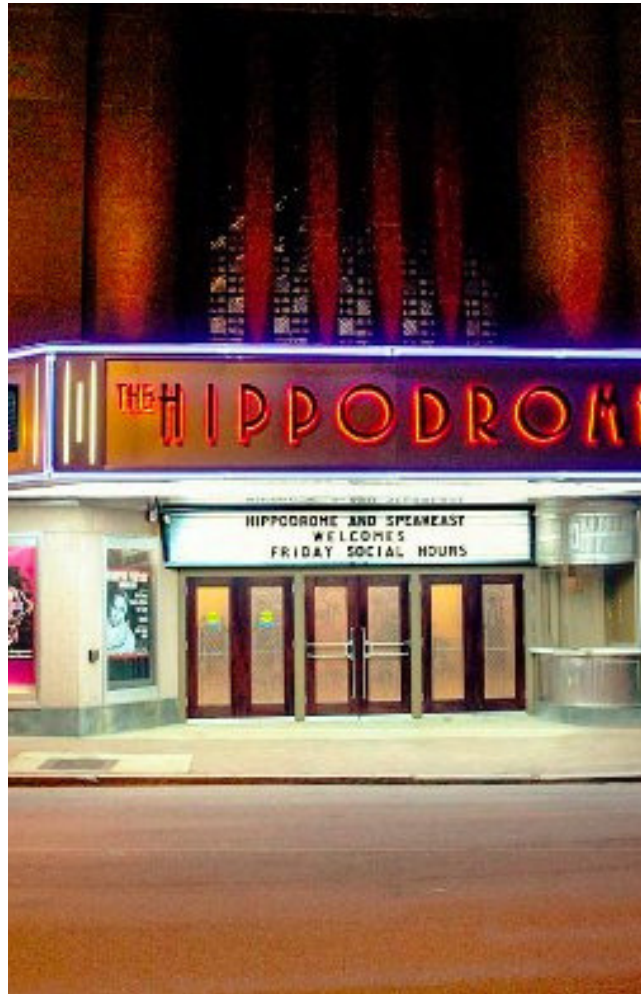

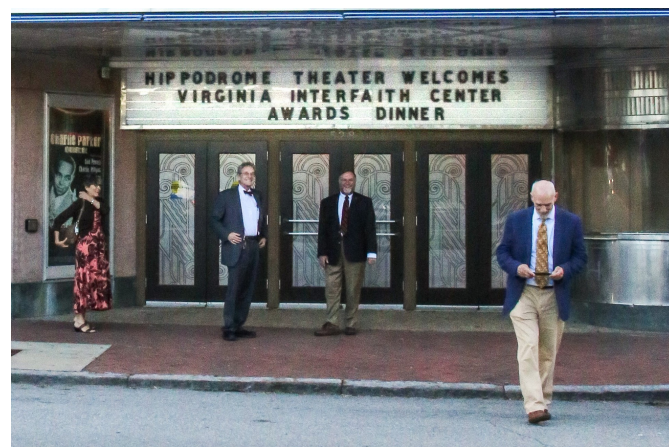

OUR STORY

The Virginia Interfaith Center advocates economic, social, racial and environmental justice in Virginia's policies and practices through education, prayer and action.



Our organization engages people of faith and other people of good will through congregations, local chapters and affiliates, college campuses and its online communities.



We are a non-partisan coalition of more than 700 faith communities working for a more just society.

OUR PRIORITIES

HEALTH EQUITY

VICPP was the leading faith voice advocating Medicaid expansion in 2018. This year, we are tapping congregations to help enroll eligible people.

WAGE JUSTICE

VICPP passed two wage theft reforms in the General Assembly in 2019 - one that removes Jim Crow exemptions from the Minimum Wage Act and the other requiring employers provide paystubs to workers.

WELCOMING ALL

VICPP seeks to make Virginia more welcoming to immigrants, people of color and other marginalized people. We advocate for Driver's Privilege Cards and In-State Tuition for immigrants, and support the Central Virginia Sanctuary Network.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM

VICPP convened a criminal justice roundtable for advocates during the 2019 General Assembly and is urging the Governor to create a taskforce to address broader reforms in 2020.

ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

VICPP merged with Virginia Interfaith Power and Light. Together, we are building support for a just transition to a clean energy economy and mobilizing faith support for Buckingham County families opposing the placement of a fracked-gas compressor station in their neighborhood.
