

CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING MAP AMENDMENT



Overview

There is an upcoming ballot initiative on the Virginia Use of Legislative Congressional Redistricting Map Amendment, scheduled for April 21, 2026. The question on the ballot will read:

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?

"YES"

A **"YES"** vote supports allowing the Virginia Legislature to conduct congressional redistricting this year.

"NO"

A **"NO"** vote opposes allowing the Virginia legislature to conduct congressional redistricting, and we continue with the previously established redistricting process.
